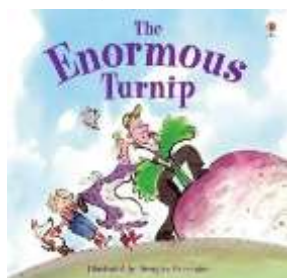
Rhyme of the Week-
