The RISE Educational Improvement Session, "Widening the Lens on Success," will focus on how Yeading Infant and Nursery School will ensure every child receives the best possible start in life while achieving strong academic attainment. Drawing on the school's vision that "everyone is valued and nurtured to grow and exceed beyond their expectations," the session will explore how success will extend beyond outcomes alone and will include wellbeing, confidence, inclusion, resilience, and personal development.

The discussion will highlight the school's ambitious and engaging curriculum, which will be carefully designed to empower children as learners and individuals. Staff will reflect on the importance of early intervention, high-quality teaching, strong relationships with families, and a language-rich environment in supporting children from diverse backgrounds to thrive. Particular attention will be given to early reading, vocabulary development, and creating meaningful learning experiences that will raise attainment while fostering curiosity and independence.

The session will also celebrate the school's inclusive culture and commitment to ensuring all pupils experience success. By widening the lens on success, staff will consider how academic achievement, personal growth, emotional wellbeing, and lifelong learning habits will work together to prepare children for future education and life beyond Yeading Infants. The session will reinforce a collective commitment to high expectations, equity, and nurturing every child's potential.
