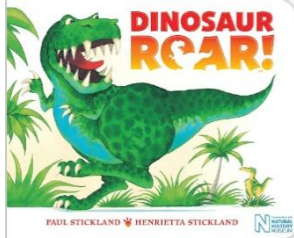
All Easter Egg designs to be brought in on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March.

### This Week



We read our new focus book 'Dinosaur Roar.'

In Maths, we have looked at what happens to our numbers when we add a number or subtract a number.

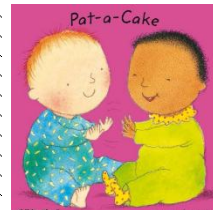
We showed the children in a circle using objects of what happens. 2 bears add one more and the number gets bigger to 3. Then we showed subtraction, have 5 bears and remove one and we saw the number got smaller.

In Phonics we have been learning the letter 'k' with lots of fun activities to encourage interaction and mark making. Please see the guidance sheet on the back of the newsletter to show you how we teach this sound.

### Next Week

We will be continuing to read our focus book 'Dinosaur Roar'. We will be discussing our favourite dinosaur and trying to explain why we like that particular dinosaur.
