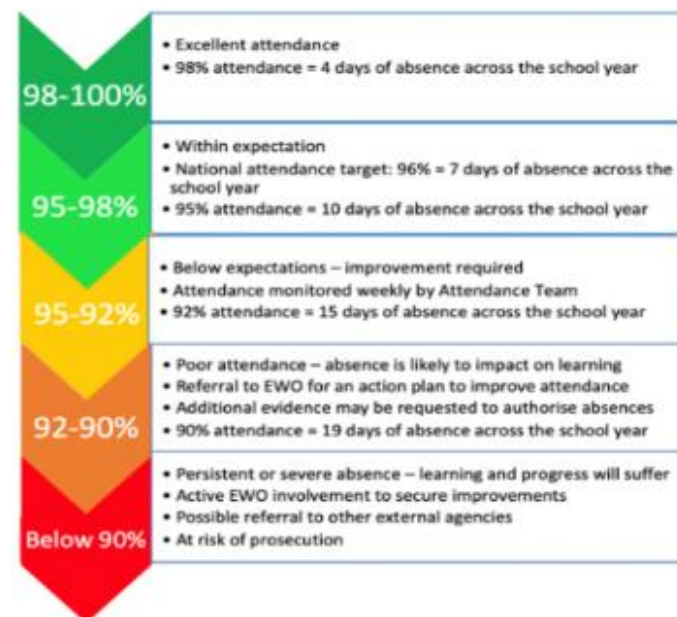

Phonics

This half term we will be working on Level 4 and 5, where the children will consolidate and practise the letter sounds, they have already learned, focusing on blending and segmenting longer words with adjacent consonants and some two-syllable words.

Maths

This week we learnt to sort 2-D shapes on the basis of one and two criteria and to recognise, complete and create patterns using 3-D shapes.

Next week the children will be learning to combine two quantities to find the total.
