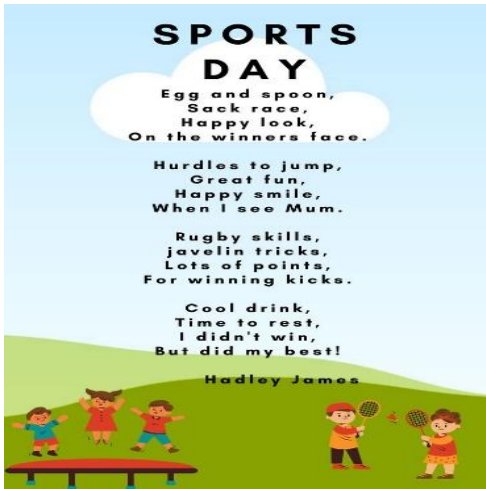
**National Numeracy Day** - Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May. Come into school wearing a number to celebrate this wonderful day!
