We have been enjoying learning about our focus book 'Oh Dear!'. The children have now able to link which animals to their homes. ( pigs-sty or horse-stable) .

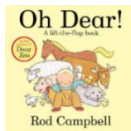
In Phonics we have been learning our new sound and letter 'f'.
