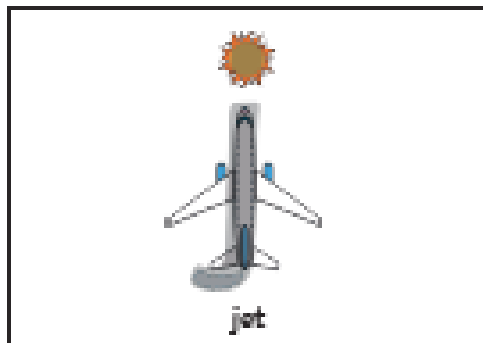

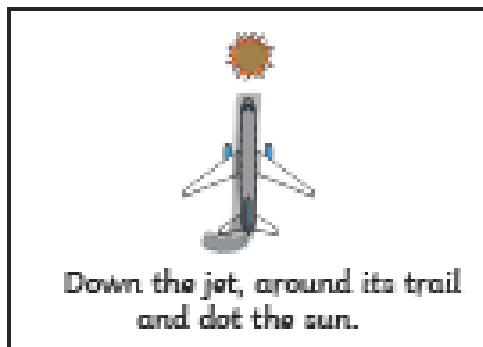

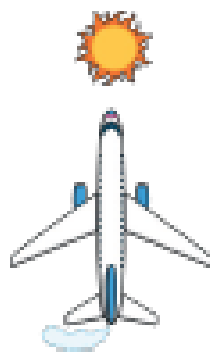

In Phonics we have been learning our new sound and letter 'j'.

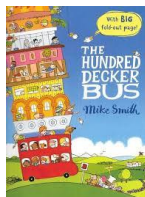
The children have been learning about the different types of transport we see and have been on.
