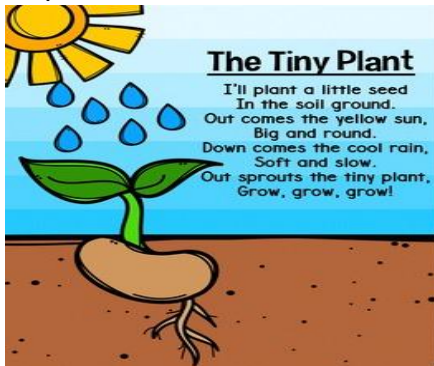

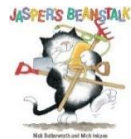
Remember to log into Bug Club!
