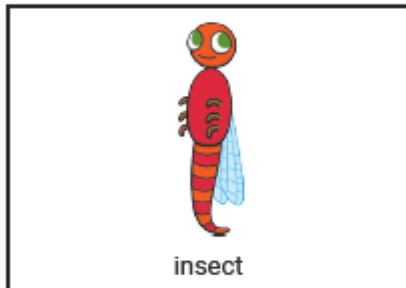

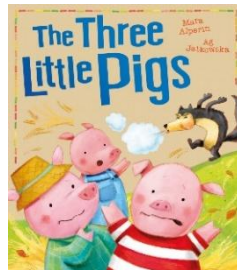
In maths, we have been practising our number recognition and counting skills to the number 4. We have been sorting different objects by colour to help us recognise the number 4.
