We have had a fun packed week in Nursery. Your children are continuing to make friends and interact with each other, which is lovely to see.

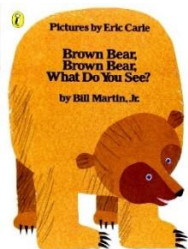
Our Learning

This Week

We have continued to share the story Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?

We even thought about other animals that could be in the book and what colour they would be.

In Phonics, the children have been exploring making noises using their voices. These noises included those that are made by animals and those noises they can hear in the environment.

This week each child was given their first **library book** to share with an adult at home. ***Please keep our books away from younger siblings and babies!*** Please ensure the book is in your child's book bag to be changed the following week.

Home Time

Health & Hygiene

Children should be entering the nursery without nappies or pull-ups. Please support children at home by encouraging them to be independent when going to the toilet. The Children's Centre (next door) may be able to provide support to parents in this area. We ask you to register with them as quickly as possible.

Please ensure your child's nails are cut short and filed down.

We ask that you teach and show children how to properly clean their runny noses so that we can limit germs spreading within Nursery.
