What We're Learning This Week!



Literacy

This week we have been looking at the story of "Dear Earth" using story map describe the setting from the story.

Next week -We will be learning to write a pledge to help save the earth.

Homework - Look at "Dear Earth" story map and talk to your child about how to save the Earth.

Phonics

This week we have been consolidating work on Phase 4 and 5 of the phonics ie as in cookie and ie as in pie, ie (e) as in alien, igh as in night and i-e (e) as in like.

In addition, we have looked at the tricky words.

Next week- we will continue to consolidate all the sounds from phase 4 and 5 such as: o-e as in globe, ow as in snow and as in owl, ou as in cloud and oe as in toe.

Homework - Children should now be writing sentences independently using their knowledge of Phase 2/3/4/5 supported by tricky words. Challenge your child to write about weekend news.

Maths

This week- we have been learning about 'Length'. We have been learning to estimate the lengths of objects and then compare and order lengths.

Next week- Our topic for next week is to explore numbers, strategy and patterns within ten.

Homework- Please encourage them to look at patterns at home, use the key vocabulary and use the word in a sentence. E.g. One , two, first, second...
