This week we enjoyed Writing Week. We read 'Ten little aliens.' We enjoyed designing our own alien.



In Phonics we have been learning the letter 'g' with lots of fun activities to encourage interaction and mark making. Please see the guidance sheet on the back of the newsletter to show you how we teach this sound.

In Maths we will be focussing on recognising, describing patterns. Use cubes, sorting bears to help show patterns. Looking at ABC patterns/e.g 1,2,3,1,2,3 Red bear, green bear, blue bear.
