tions that helped our understanding of the world around us.

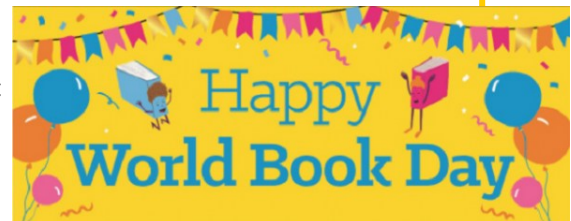
Thank you to Mrs Bhamvra for organising such an exciting week, including the ducklings from the farm which were so well looked after by the children.
