

# Primary Sports Funding Statement

We continue to commit to delivering high-quality Physical Education and sporting activities. We provide 2 hours of PE each week in gymnastics, dance and games. The planned PE curriculum is further complemented by active playtimes and after-school sports clubs which include Riding, Dance, Football, Taekwondo and Multi-Sports.

Our aim is to give every child the opportunity to develop a healthy and active lifestyle: we value and recognise the importance of developing the children's physical, emotional and social well-being.

## **Primary PE & Sports funding: how it has been used**

From September 2013 the Government has provided additional funding directly to primary schools to be spent on improving the provision of PE and sport

This year (2021-22) we have been allocated Primary Sports Funding received £23852 we have spent £17845. The decision was made to pay for the services of a PE specialist from the South Hillingdon School Sports Network (SHSSN) using the allocated money. The specialist has provided us with a day a week to support staff and children, concentrating on all aspects of physical education

A Change4Life club was also set up to help children to develop healthier lifestyles. The children have also been competing in games within the school and across other schools in the SHSSN.

## **How impact has been measured:**

Specialist termly observations are made by the PE co-ordinator to measure the impact of the PE & Sports funding, who has observed that it has helped in the overall delivery of PE and sporting activities. For example, there is now:

- greater confidence in planning and delivering the Funs P.E Scheme
- an increase in the number of children taking part in after-school activities
- an increase in the number of clubs on offer and pupil participation in PE and sport.

We hope the extra investment into PE and sport will benefit our pupils in the future, and will continue to monitor our delivery to ensure that this is the case.
